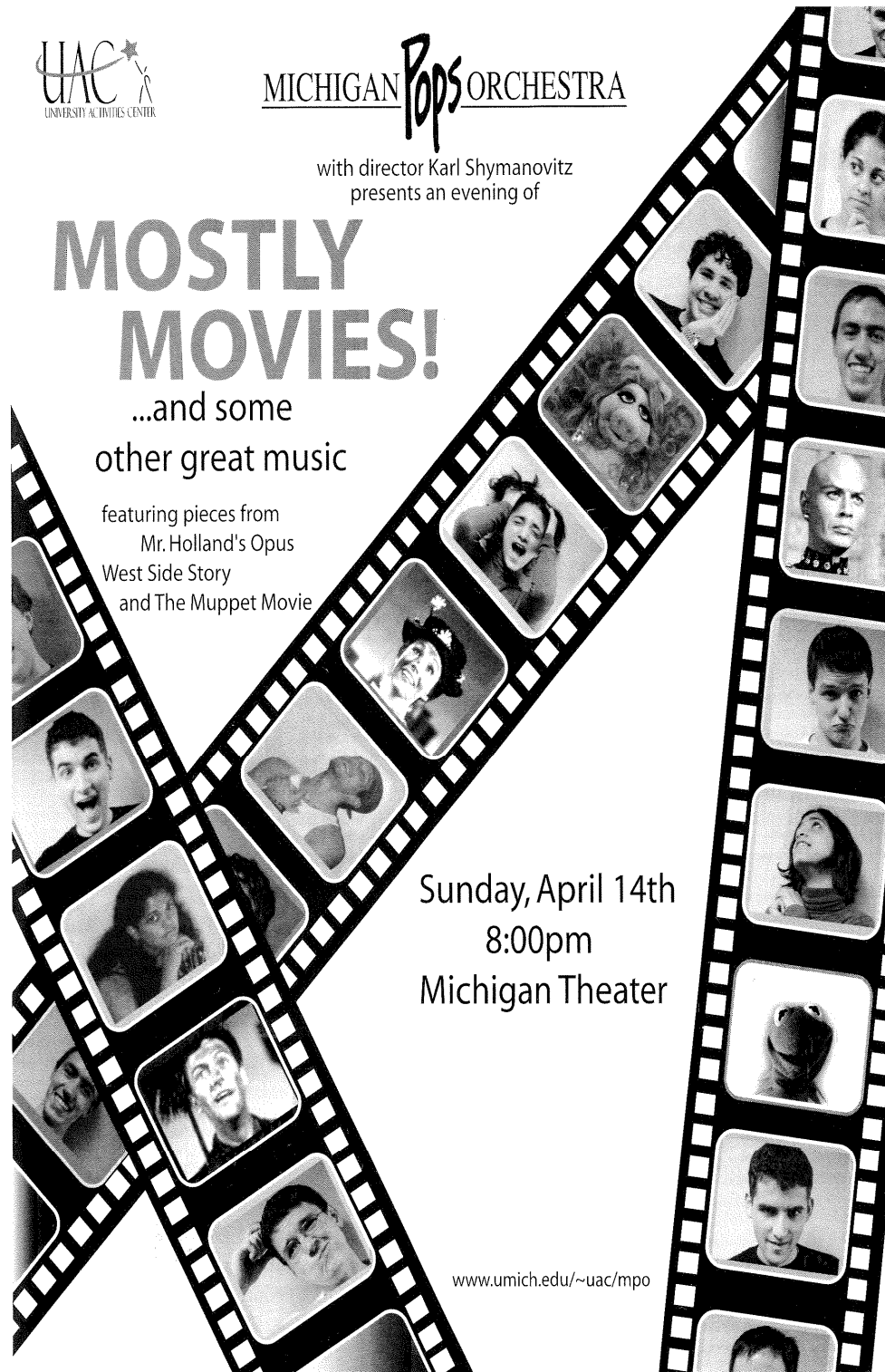

Tonight marks Karl’s first performance with the Michigan Pops Orchestra, as its Conductor and Music Director. Karl is a senior Piano Performance Major in the School of Music and is looking forward to a career as a Broadway Music Director. He has conducted numerous musicals for MUSKET (UAC) and other theatre groups in Michigan. Some credits include: *Evita*, *Godspell*, *Little Shop of Horrors*, *Jesus Christ Superstar*, *The Music Man*, *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, and *Trespases* (a new musical by a recent U of M graduate). He has also spent the last two summers as Assistant Music Director at Theatre-by-the-Sea in Southern Rhode Island and will return this summer as Musical Director. He works very closely with the U of M Musical Theatre Department as an accompanist for the University Productions, auditions, voice lessons, and dance classes. As a pianist, he has played solo performances with the University of Michigan Symphony Orchestra, after winning last year’s annual Concerto Competition in the School of Music, and also with the Interlochen Arts Academy Orchestra, the Livonia Symphony Orchestra, and the Kalamazoo and Grand Rapids Youth Symphonies. Last semester he conducted this orchestra in the smash hit “613 Miles Off Broadway.” After graduation, he plans to move to New York and live in a small apartment that costs too much money with nothing but a piano and a bed in it, and follow his dreams.
