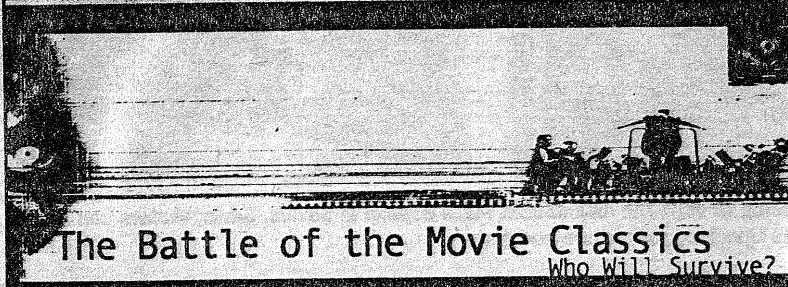

Orchestra performs classic movie music

choir from Detroit, and the University's Festival Chorus will perform the "Duel of the Fates" in concert premiere. Later in the concert, the two groups will join together again to perform a selection from "Carmina Burana," which was featured in the film, "Glory."

As an added attraction, composer Conrad Pope will be presenting a pre-concert lecture. The subject of Pope's talk will be the film music industry. Pope has worked as an orchestrator for the music from "Star Wars — The Phantom Menace." In addition, he has worked with John Williams, James Horner and Danny Elfman. Pope is currently working on the orchestration and score for "Sleepy Hollow."

His lecture will begin at 7 p.m. and is available to all ticketholders. Tickets to the Saturday concert are priced at \$5 for students, seniors, and children. \$7 as general admission.
