verything you know anous the low-fi revolution is wrong. Schadoh, Guided by Voices and Royal Trux are all riding the late freight, let the mid-70k, Detroit's DENTROY ALL MONETERS were already polluting the underground with their crude attulio science and high-energy att sahotage. Operating in a remote quadrant of the pre-punk universe — bordered by the early Velvet Underground, the Stoogges Fan House, the fire houk of old ESP Disk jazz scoords and the German bands Can and Faust—the Meuscen worked in determined isolation, gagging little and issuing no records. In 1977, ex-Stooges guitarist Ron Asheton joined, and the group went into biker-metal overdrive. But Destroy All Moneter 1974-1976 (Pather Yod, Estratic Peace, three-CD set) is the original primal stew, 210 minutes of dense, lavistly packaged, recorded wholly without compromise.
