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Honor Policy

- **All students** in the College of Engineering are presumed to be decent, honest people, and to abide by reasonable standards of conduct.

- **All homework** must be completed individually. You are encouraged to form groups and to discuss homework assignments **at the conceptual level** with your fellow students. This includes discussing problem strategies and working out mathematical details. Assignment write-up should be done without help from fellow students. Copying from a current or former student, a former instructor, is an honor code violation.
- **You must abide** by any special instructions given with any assignment or quiz.

Grading Policy

Assignments There will be 6 assignments over the course of the term. They will vary in length and difficulty. Some will be “single” weight, others “double”. Each will be posted on the class website, sometimes earlier than the time specified in “The Schedule”. The due dates of the assignments are specified in the write up of each assignment. Late turn in is not permitted.

Quizzes Approximately 10 quizzes will be given during term. They may be given in class or posted on line. These quizzes are each worth approximately 1% of your grade. If more than 10 quizzes are assigned, only the best 10 will count toward you grade. If less than 10 are posted, they will be prorated so that the total amount will be 10%.

These quizzes have several purposes: 1) to encourage questions in class, 2) to test your understanding of the required reading, 3) to test your comprehension of material already covered.

Assignment/quiz regrade policy There are no regrades except for a demonstrable grading error, or an ambiguity that was not clarified before submission.

Exams There are no exams. Grades are determined by assignments and in-class quizzes only.
