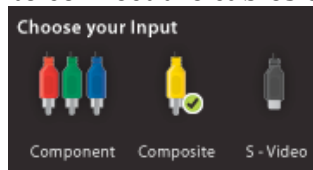
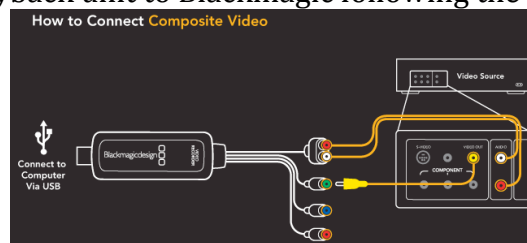


## How to digitize using Blackmagic in G333

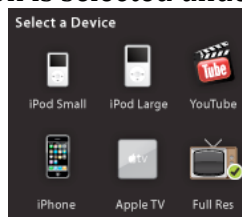
1. Make sure the Blackmagic device is plugged into the back (right side) of the iMac. If it is not, plug it in to an available USB port.
2. Open the Blackmagic software.
  - a. It is located at: Applications → Blackmagic Video Recorder, and is also on the DIGITIZE external hard drive.
3. Look at your video playback unit (VCR, DVD player, video camera, etc.) and decide which output type you will be using.
  - a. Typically, you'll use composite (RCA) cables (yellow, red, & white plugs).
  - b. Blackmagic can also handle component (red, white, green, blue, and red plugs) and s-video (red, white, and black plugs) cables.
    - i. S-video requires the adapter located on the shelf, beside the DVD player.
4. Go back to the Blackmagic software and select the correct input device on the left side. It will show you the proper way to connect the cables on the screen.



5. Connect your video playback unit to Blackmagic following the on-screen instructions.



6. Make sure that the "Full Res" option is selected under "Select a Device."



7. Enter a file name for the video clip you're digitizing in the left column.

*Tip: Do not use special characters. Limit the file name to letters, numbers, & spaces.*
8. Use the video playback unit (VCR, DVD player, video camera, etc.) to play the video and determine the proper start-point for the digitization. The video will be displayed in the Blackmagic software window.
9. To digitize, press PLAY on the video playback unit and click the big, red button on the Blackmagic software window. The digitization process will begin.
10. When you've reached the end of the video clip you're digitizing, press the big, red button again to stop digitizing. You may then stop playing the video as well.
11. The digitized video file will immediately appear on the iMac's desktop. When you're done digitizing all of the clips, move those files to their destination (such as the DIGITIZE external hard drive).
  - a. We save our clips in: DIGITIZE → Blackmagic → *Your Name* → *Video Title*
